

## CHEADLE GOLF CLUB HEAD GREENKEEPER

Cheadle Golf Club is also responsible for the maintenance of the Pitch and Putt course at Bruntwood Park which is located ¼ mile from the Golf Club. The successful candidate will be responsible for the maintenance of both courses.

The role is permanent and full-time. As a key member of the team, you will be responsible for the development of a course maintenance programme which will ensure both courses are presented in the best possible condition at all times.

Working within a small team, the role will involve many normal greenkeeping duties as well as the supervisory role. The successful applicant will be trained to NVQ Level 3 or equivalent and have a minimum five years' hands-on greenkeeping experience together with some experience of greens team management.
